

**BOROUGH OF PARAMUS
ORDINANCE #2025-12**

**AN ORDINANCE ADDING A
NEW CHAPTER 35 TO THE BOROUGH CODE TO BE TITLED "EMPLOYEES, PART TIME
AND SEASONAL"**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Paramus, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A.40:48-1, 40:49-2 and 40A:9-165, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Paramus hereby amend the Borough Code to create a new Chapter 35 to be titled "Employees, Part Time and Seasonal" to read as follows:

Article I: Senior Pistol Range Maintainer

§ 35-28. Office Created:

The office of Senior Pistol Range Maintainer – Part Time in and for the Borough of Paramus is hereby created, subject to the provisions of this chapter.

§ 35-29. Appointment.

The Senior Pistol Range Maintainer shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council.

§ 35-30. Compensation.

The Senior Pistol Range Maintainer shall receive such compensation as shall be fixed, from time to time, by the general salary ordinance of the Borough of Paramus.

§ 35-31. Requirements

The Senior Pistol Range Maintainer shall meet the following requirements:

- LICENSE:
 - i. Applicant must possess a current and valid New Jersey Firearms Instructor Certificate or equivalent.
 - ii. Applicant must be CPR certified

§ 35-05. Powers and Duties

1. Responsible for general Repairs and maintenance of the target system and backstop.
2. Keeping an updating inventory of PPE and equipment used on the range.
3. Vacuum the range floor and take out any garbage.
4. Perform pistol qualifications.



5. Assist the Training Unit with weapon training.
6. Operate and maintain the TI simulator.
7. Oversee any contracted maintenance and repair of the range.
8. Oversee ordering of needed supplies for range.
9. Make sure agencies utilizing the range follow correct procedures.
10. Any other tasks the Supervisor in charge of the range deems necessary.


Section 2. REPEALER. All prior ordinances that are inconsistent with the ordinance are repealed.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and publication of notice of adoption as provided by law.
